









Kidnapped by an UFO



However, not even with him she shares her secret.














Back home another headache is waiting for Sailor Moon. Mamoru still rebuffs her...










While Esmeralda is preparing her attack, Bunny drowns her misery with lots of cakes in a pastry shop.

Meanwhile, Mamoru and Chibiusa enter the pastry shop. However, there is no time for Bunny to get jealous:




A new Monster stands ready to take on any adversary.

























They sell lucky charm bracelets, and they even offer classes to learn how to make one yourself.




A new shop has opened downtown. At school, everyone is talking about it.

In the nick of time, Luna can tear it off her wrist. These lucky charm bracelets must have been jinxed by the enemy!






Ray advises Bunny to seize the occasion.

Artemis discovers an organisation capturing animals for lab tests. The poor creatures must be rescued!






The Sailor Warriors come to help the animals. They find out that the enemy from Crystal Tokyo is behind all that animal testing.




What you need:


- A large sheet of gift wrapping paper.
 You may need to glue to sheets together.
- Thin, 60 cm long wood or bamboo dowels, about 3 cm in diameter.
- Used matchsticks don't use new ones that were never lighted!
- tin cap rings (detach the rings from the caps, and flatten them out but take care not to cut yourself).



- Thin string. The thicker the string, the heavier your kite will be!
- A ruler, a pencil, scissors, and glue.









- 1. Fold the paper lengthwise in half. Mark two dots one left, one right 21 cm below the top edge.
- 2. Fold the sheet at the level of these dots.
- 3. Unfold the sheet and mark two more dots as seen in the illustration above.
- 4. Connect the dots using a ruler, and draw a parallel line 2 cm apart from the first one. Now cut along this second line.
- 5. Fold the edges along the first line, and press them down firmly. Now unfold the edges and the sheet.
- Flip the sheet over, and draw lines along the unfolded edges (again using a ruler). Mark the points with letters as shown in the illustration above, and cut off the corners.


- 1. Place marks along the vertical and the cross-spar as shown in the illustration below.
- 2. Put glue along the line A-C on the paper and on the vertical spar. Let the glue dry thoroughly. The marks on the spar are fitting the edges of the sail.
- 3. Now glue the cross-spar on the paper along the line D-E, and press down firmly.
- 4. When the glue has dried, fold and unfold the edges again to get a clearly marked fold.






The Frame

- 1. Cut a piece of string 4x the length of the vertical spar, and mark the middle.
- 2. At point A put some glue around the vertical spar, and tie the string around fastening it with a knot. The middle should be exactly at point A. Put some glue on the knot as well.
- 3. Now spread some glue along the edges A-D and A-E, and place one end of the string in each fold. Fold the edges around the string and press down firmly.
- 4. After putting some glue around the cross-spar at points D and E, tie the string around and fasten with knots.
- 5. Now spread some glue along the remaining folds, place the string in them and fold them down.
- 6. Tie the string around point C fastening it with a knot. Put some glue on the knot and the vertical spar.
- 7. Cut four triangles from the leftover paper and glue them on the four corners of your kite.




The Bridle

- 1. Use a needle to pierce two opposite holes at point B. Thread the string through the needle.
- 2. Place the kite spars up. Thread the needle through one hole from below and then through the other from above. Repeat, and flip the kite over.



- 3. Pull the string out to get a loose end of circa 10 cm. Now tie a double knot, and glue the string onto the sail.
- 4. Now the bridle should be around 70 to 80 cm long.
- 5. Fasten the tin cap ring to the bridle, circa 25 cm away from the kite. Tie the knot as shown in the illustration above.




1. For the tail use coloured wrapping tissue cut into 3 cm wide rectangles. Glue them together to form 4 strips of 4 m length each.

2. When the glue has dried, crumple up the strips and unfold them. Your kite will not fly with smooth strips!

3. Spread some glue along a 9 cm long part of the end of a strip. Then, fold it three times. Each fold should be about 3 cm long (illustration 1).

- 4. Fold the edges to the inside and glue them down (illustrations 2 and 3).
- 5. When the glue has dried, use a needle to pierce a hole into each folded end. Thread a 15 cm long piece of string through all three holes and tie the ends.
- 6. Now push the matchstick through the knot at the lower end of your kite, and attach the string holding the tail to it.


