



I have a confession -- I really wanted to become Super Jetta Man when I was a kid growing up.

Editor in Chief of "Soiree" - Actor Mitsuya Yuuji You don't know what "Super Jetta Man" is? Well, when I was a young kid, it was a hugely popular animated TV show. (I'm sure all of your moms and dads out there know it very well.)

At night, I used to lie in my bed and dream about becoming Super Jetta Man someday. It was such an amazing feeling to pretend to be riding into the morning on the tail of a shooting star. And when I was allowed to watch TV in the afternoon, I was glued to the screen.

My classmates wanted to be like Kamen Rider, Ultraman, and people like that. At recess, we all used to take notepaper, draw on the face of our favorite heros, and run around playing and pretending to be them.

For girls, all there really was to play as was "The Secrets of Akko-chan" or "Magical Witch Sally."

All they really had to play with were cute little dolls to dress up or coloring books; each time she received one, a girl's eyes lit up and shined while thinking about having a new thing to play with, but the truth is that these girls were dreaming in their seats - all their play had no action.

That's just how it was. During the Showa era, fathers worked, mothers kept house, boys watched science-fiction anime, and girls were into romantic stories while daydreaming. Boys idolized Mazinger Z, Combattler V, Gundam, and so on and so forth, whereas girls idolized Oka Hiromi, Candy, Little Orphan Annie... and so on and so forth.



Basically, boys's anime focused on battles between good and evil with a science fiction theme, whereas girl's anime focused on love stories and heart-throbbing romance.

But then, the Heisei era came along...

It was an age where boys became newscasters, defense ministers, taxi drivers, policemen, diplomats, college professors, and women were finally able to begin entering the work force. Of course, women never did get to hold the same equality as men, not even in the workplace, but equality was at least something that was plausible.

But as more and more women started working, and didn't become wives, many young girls also wanted to live their lives as career women too.Unfortunately in the world of animation, there still existed a very strict gender separation between boys and girls stories. "Girls shouldn't be interested in fighting evil", "Girl's shouldn't be allies of justice", is what people said. But oh, how the world has changed since then.

A new superhero called "Pretty Soldier sailormoon" showed up on the scene. The protagonist, Tsukino Usagi, is a bit of a crybaby and a bit of a comedian. She's an average middle school student. But then out of nowhere, this regular girl is able to transform by grabbing a mysterious brooch and shouting "Moon Moon Prism Power Make Up!" and becomes Sailormoon. But hey, if one of us were approached by a black cat with a brooch, we probably wouldn't take it. And we definitely wouldn't turn into Sailormoon either. This new work has a larger than life appeal to young girls. And somehow, this anime has become hugely successful, which is a fascination unto itself. And now, it's even got its own musical.

It's become the most popular magical girls show ever. It's even a bigger hit than Peter Pan and the Wizard of Oz and Saint Seiya, all of which have their own musicals as well. It is an especially wonderful thing to see an animated image right in front of your eyes having become tangible. It is absolutely amazing.

Anyway, in the musicals the sailor soldiers and Tuxedo Mask sing and dance. The actors give an absolutely wonderful performance on stage, and although the experience is much different from watching the anime or reading the comics, it really is a nice little treat to go and see it. Although you can watch the anime episodes again and again or read the comics any time you'd like, seeing a Sailormoon musical performance is something you can really only do once. From beginning to end, the show is really entertaining. And if you don't watch it, well, in the name of the moon you'll be punished! Of course, anime is just anime, no matter how you cut it. "No matter how hard you wish for it, it just won't ever be as large as the life you're living", I'm sure you've heard friends say, but have they ever transformed like Sailormoon has?

You should definitely take any friends you have like that to come and see the musical "Pretty Soldier Sailormoon". They'll be able to see Tsukino Usagi, Mizuno Ami, Tuxedo Mask, and the others up close and personal right in front of their eyes. "But I've never gone to see a musical, I'm worried they've messed up Sailormoon, I don't want to go", I'm sure you've heard someone say that too. They would be surprised -- the anime and musicals are actually very similar.



Currently, she instructs the girl's university within the Tokyo Performing Arts Academy, and leads "Yanagi Akiko's Jazz Dance City", a performance to train her beginning dancers. She currently also works in choreography in stage and cinema performances. Her works include "No Strings", "The Borlaise Revue", "Broadway Bound", "Jazz Dance from N.Y.", and others.

## Composer Kosaka Akiko

After that, she became a musical director, composer, and arranger for commercial songs, anime music, childrens' music, game music, musical scores, and so forth. Her works include, "You", "One More Time", "Takeda Haranobu", "Meiji Almond Flavored Candy CM", "JT Tobacco Commercial", "93 Sailormoon S Movie Theme Song 'Moon Revenge", TV Anime "Sailormoon S Ending Theme 'Tuxedo Mirage", and others.



## Composer Tsuno Gouji

I spent a lot of time by night in the branch office for Sailormoon production. A fan of synthesizer music creation, this musician has traveled the whole world and has a very ecclectic taste in composition. He has worked as an artist, and a sound producer for various animated series, films, musicals, commercials, video games, and other works as a composor, arranger, and lyricist. He continues to work as a solo artist as well. He won the prestitious Japan Gold Disc award two times in a row in 1991 and again and 1992. His works include "Bird-Man Sentai Jetman", "Dinosaur Attack Force Beast Rangers", "Southern Country Boy Papuwa-kun", and others.



## Lyricist Fuyumori Kayoko

My friend Saccha always said that for women, practice is a necessity. Because what women do influences the next generation, and so we must strive for perfection. And it was with this in mind that I went about creating all of the songs for "Sailormoon", with the aspiration that my hard work would pay off. When the producer was first beginning to cast the roles, he said what matters most was "The legs". "The legs" he said "Must be beautiful", because "Beautiful legs are strong legs" and he told me to base who I chose to perform based on that criteria. After graduating from Waseda University, she went to America. While living in America, she took part in a Japan-America exchange of musicians, and translated a number of poems. After returning to Japan, she worked as an author, and after realizing there was a demand for song writing she entered the field. Her works include: musicals - "Galaxy Railroad 999", "The Paradise of Ginza", "Carmen", "Annie Get Your Guori", "The Sailormoon Theme Song", "Dr. Slump", "Ninja Sentai Kakuranger", as well as the lyrics for "Lots Gboobs", "Moon Revenge", "TANGO NOIR" (with Nakamori Akina), and others. She was also a winner of the Japan Gold Disk prize.

I really put a lot of focus on lighting each anime character individually in this musical to make them stand out more, and tried out some new techniques that I have learned. I hope you will enjoy the results!




